Launched in January 2025, the Book Nook has caught the attention of staff and students alike with the books it displays and its commitment to bringing in new and updated themes. [Read More](#)

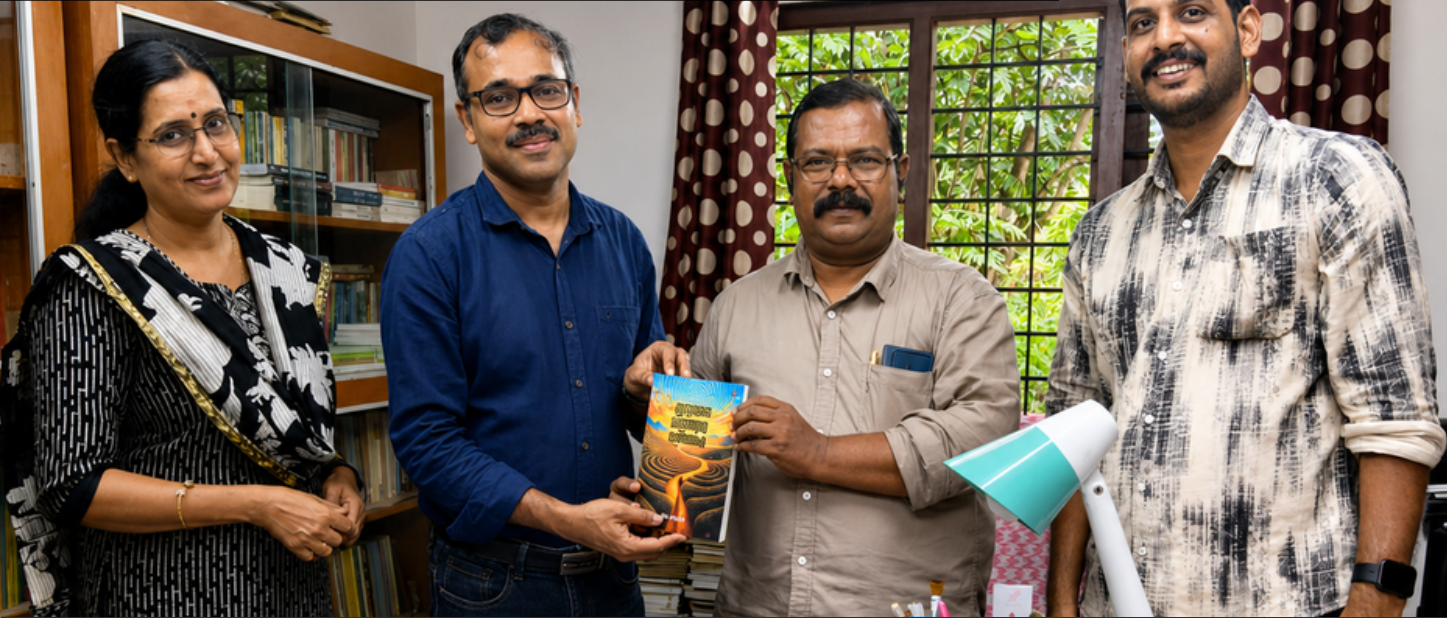

K. P. Surendran, a Salesman at a ration shop in Piravom, Ernakulam district, is in a daily love affair with books. For the past forty years, he has been setting aside a fixed amount every month to buy, read, and beautifully preserve old and new books. He has a collection of more than 8000 books and finds continuous reading both a habit and an intoxication. Books fill every nook and corner of his house. Through dedicated reading of fiction, poetry, drama, and more, he has acquired vast knowledge, perhaps at par with, or even beyond, academic standards.

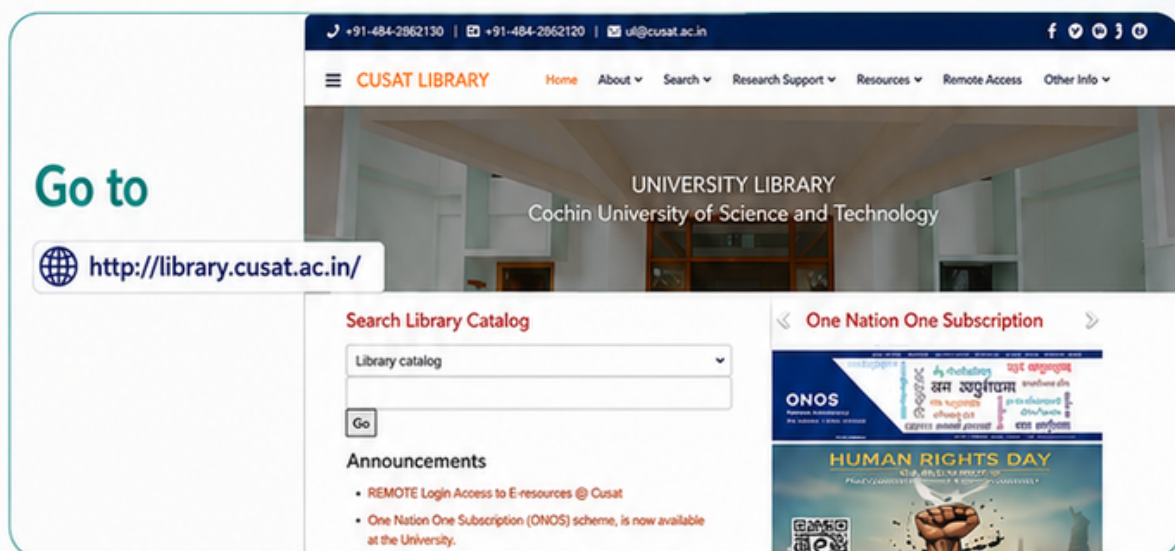
